What exactly will I be doing?

If you join the group, you will have meetings and workshops with other young people to talk about your experiences with heritage and how we can make them better. This will be a co-designed project which means it's up to you what exactly you do. For example, you may want to make videos, create a presentation for organisations or just talk to others.

What's in it for me?

We hope that you will enjoy the opportunity to have your voice heard and be able to decide on your own project. Being part of a national project is a great thing to put on your CV. There will also be a chance to learn about different heritage in England.

How much commitment will it take?

The project will run from July until the end of December 2022. We would like you to join the rest of the group for online meetings and workshops once or twice a month and meet in person at least once. Funding will be provided for young people and their guardians if an in-person event is arranged.
